It can also optionally warn about files on disk that are not included in a project. The Visual Studio 2019 version can be found here . You can trigger the extension by performing a build on the solution or an individual project.

In the Folder Options or File Explorer Options window, click View tab, under Hidden files and folders, click Show hidden files, folders, and drives option. Step 3. Then click Apply, then OK. You'll see the files of the USB drive.

You can get VS.NET to display all open miscellaneous files in the Solution Explorer. If you open the Options dialog box (Tools → Options) and expand the Environment folder, you will see a Documents item on the left. When you select this, one of the options presented on the right is "Show Miscellaneous Files in Solution Explorer."

1. Solutions and Projects - Mastering Visual Studio .NET ...

As fast as you can type, Visual Studio searches your entire solution for a file or path that starts with the characters you type and you can quickly select that file (with the keyboard using the arrow keys if you wish) and open it. If you're working in a solution with several projects or folders, this can be a significant time saver.

Visual Studio trick to quickly find any file in solution ...

Show All Files By default, JetBrains Rider only displays projects, files and references that are included in the current solution. You can use the Show All Files option to additionally display all subdirectories and files that are located on the file system under the solution directory.

Right-click on the solution → Unhide Folders (or with the solution selected, click the Project menu → Unhide Folders) Example: Organizing My Demo Projects. I presented my first ever session in 2014. Actually its a feature to show/hide file names while in Thumbnails mode. For Windows Vista and Later: 1. Open the folder which has this problem. 2. Right-click in empty area and uncheck "View -> Hide File names" option. 3. If this option is not available, press and hold SHIFT key, right-click in empty area and select "View -> Medium Icons" option.

[Solution] File & Folder Names are not Visible in Windows ...

Look for the button you added on the Solution Explorer toolbar. It should be the fourth button from the left. When you click the button, all the files should be filtered out, and you should see All items have been filtered from view. in the Solution Explorer .

Extending the Solution Explorer Filter - Visual Studio ...

There is a button in Solution Explorer called "Show all files" which shows all the files even if not declared in the manifest as those not declared are grayed out. You can right click one of those grayed out files and add it to the project, which declares it in t

Why do files created outside of Visual Studio not show up ...

I tried checking in by right clicking on solution name. It did check-in some other files. However, new files are still not showing up in his solution explorer. No files are checked out at his end.
