Inter-professional working is constantly promoted to professionals within the health and social care sector. Various terms such as interdisciplinary, multidisciplinary and interagency collaboration working have been used to promote professionals to work together with the patient, carers, relations, services and other professionals (SCIE, 2009).

How interprofessional learning improves care

Interprofessional collaborative practice skills build over time and must commence within pre-service learning. IPP reflects collaboration and teamwork, where all members have an equal voice, and they understand and respect each other's roles and responsibilities. In response, there is an increasing quest for a definition of interprofessional competencies [1]. Among these, the understanding and appreciation of one's own and others' roles and responsibilities are highlighted as a core competence of interprofessional work as a prerequisite for effective communication [2].
