Catholic Doctrine on the Holy Trinity

PROTESTANT: A Protestant is any person who has received Trinitarian baptism and still believes in the Trinity (making him/her technically a "baptized Catholic" or "Christian"), but who simultaneously rejects some or most of the teachings of the Catholic Church.

Difference between catholic and protestant trinity ...

Trinity was the code name of the first detonation of a nuclear device. It was conducted by the United States Army at 5:29 a.m. on July 16, 1945, as part of the Manhattan Project . The test was conducted in the Jornada del Muerto desert about 35 miles (56 km) southeast of Socorro, New Mexico , on what was then the USAAF Alamogordo Bombing and Gunnery Range, now part of White Sands Missile Range .

All traditional protestant groups accept the idea of the trinity. Only relatively recently (the last two hundred years) have religious groups begun to question the trinity.
