Anton Chekhov finished his schooling in 1879 and moved to Moscow to join his family. He studied medicine at Moscow University and qualified as a doctor in 1884. He practiced as a doctor despite writing over four hundred short stories in his short life (died of Tuberculosis at just 44 years old).
